3.0 ND ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

3.1. SCHOOL OF BUSINESS STUDIES

Applicants must possess WASC/SSCE/NECO/NABTEB/GCE O'Level with Credit passes in five (5) relevant subjects obtained at not more than two sittings.

A Accountancy

Applicants must possess O'Level Credit passes in five (5) relevant subjects which must include:

- (i) English and Mathematics
- (ii) Any one (1) of Economics/Commerce, Accounting/Book Keeping,
- (iii) Plus any two (2) of Biology/Agricultural Science/Animal Husbandry/Chemistry/ Physics, ICT/Data Processing/Computer, Economics/Commerce, Accounting/Book Keeping, Government/Civic Education, Geography

(B) Banking & Finance

Applicants must possess five credits passes as stated in "A" above

(C) Business Administration and Management

Applicants must possess five credit passes as stated in "A" above

(D) Marketing

Applicant must possess five credit passes as stated in "A" above

(E) Office Technology and Management

Applicant must possess five O'Level credit passes in relevant subjects which must include:

- (i) English and Mathematics
- (ii) Any one (1) of Economics, Commerce, Accounting, Book Keeping
- (iii) Any one (1) of Government, Civic Education, CRS, IRS
- (iv) Plus any one (1) of ICT, Computer, Data Processing, Literature-in-English, Shorthand, Typewriting, Office Practice, Biology, Agricultural Science, Animal Husbandry, Physics, Chemistry

(F) Purchasing and Supply

Applicants must possess five credit passes as stated in "A" above

3.2 SCHOOL OF ENGINEERING

Applicants must possess WASC/SSCE/NECO/NABTEB/GCE O'Level with Credit passes in five (5) relevant subjects obtained at not more than two sittings.

(A) Agricultural & Bio-Environmental Engineering Technology

Applicants must possess O'Level credit passes in five relevant subjects which must include:

- (i) English, Mathematics, Physics and Chemistry
- (ii) Plus any one of Biology/Agricultural Science/Animal Husbandry, Technical Drawing, Economics, Further Mathematics, ICT, Data Processing, Computer, Statistics

(B) Agricultural Technology

Applicants must possess O'Level credit passes in five relevant subjects which must include:

- (i) English, Mathematics, Chemistry and one (1) of Biology/Agricultural Science/Animal Husbandry
- (ii) Plus any one (1) of Physics, Economics, Geography, ICT, Data Processing, Computer, Statistics, Food & Nutrition

(C) Civil Engineering

Applicants must possess O'Level credit passes in five relevant subjects which must include:

- (i) English, Mathematics, Physics and Chemistry
- (ii) Plus any one (1) of Technical Drawing, Building Drawing, Economics, Further Mathematics, Data Processing, ICT, Computer, Statistics, Civic Education, Geography, Building Construction, Block Laying, Decoration, Plumbing and Pipe Fitting, Carpentry and Joinery, Woodwork.

However, candidates with NABTEB O' Level results must have a credit pass in a related Trade Subject in addition to the Credit passes in five (5) O'Level subject requirements.

(D) Electrical/Electronic Engineering

Applicants must possess O'Level credit passes in five relevant subjects which must include:

- (i) English, Mathematics, Physics and Chemistry.
- (ii) Plus any one (1) of Technical Drawing, Further Mathematics, Economics, Geography, Electrical Installation & Maintenance Works, Radio/Television and Electrical Works,

Appliances Maintenance and Repairs, Instrument Mechanics, Building Drawing, Basic Electronics/Electricity, ICT, Data Processing, Computer

However, candidates with NABTEB O' Level results must have a credit pass in a related Trade Subject in addition to the Credit passes in five (5) O'Level subject requirements.

OR National Technical Certificate (NTC) issued by National Business and Technical Education Board (NABTEB) with Credit Passes in Mathematics, Integrated Science, English Language, Physics and a core subject in Electrical/Electronic Trade Areas which can be in any of the underlisted.

- (i) Radio, Television & Electronics works
- (ii) Instrument Mechanics
- (iii) Appliances Maintenance & Repairs
- (iv) Electrical Installation & Maintenance Works.

(E) Mechanical Engineering

Applicants must possess O'Level credit passes in five relevant subjects which must include:

- (i) English, Mathematics, Physics and Chemistry
 - (ii) Plus any one (1) of Biology, Agricultural Science, Animal Husbandry, Further Mathematics, Economics, Statistics, Building Drawing, Technical Drawing, Metal Work, Auto Mechanics, ICT, Data Processing, Computer
- However, candidates with NABTEB O' Level results must have a credit pass in a related Trade Subject relevant to Mechanical Engineering in addition to the Credit passes in five (5) O'Level subject requirements. **OR** National Technical Certificate (NABTEB) in Mechanical Trade Areas with 5 Credit Passes in Metal Work/Technical Drawing, English Language, Mathematics, Integrated Physical Science (i.e. Physics and Chemistry).

(F) Minerals and Petroleum Resources Engineering Technology

Applicants must possess O'Level credit passes in five relevant subjects which must include:

- (i) English, Mathematics, Physics and Chemistry
- (ii) Plus any one (1) of Economics, Geography, Statistics, Further Mathematics, Technical Drawing, Biology, Agricultural Science, Animal Husbandry, Building Drawing

3.3 SCHOOL OF ENVIRONMENTAL STUDIES

Applicants must possess WASC/SSCE/NECO/NABTEB/GCE O'Level with Credit passes in five (5) relevant subjects obtained at not more than two sittings.

(A) Building Technology

Applicants must possess O'Level credit passes in five relevant subjects which must include:

- (i) English, Mathematics, Physics/Chemistry
- (ii) Plus any two (2) of Physics, Chemistry, Technical Drawing/Fine Art/Building Drawing/ Building Construction/Block Laying/Woodwork/Carpentry & Joinery/Painting/Decoration/ Plumbing and Pipe Fitting, Commerce/Government, Biology/Agricultural Science/Animal Husbandry, Geography, Further Mathematics,

(B) Quantity Surveying

Applicants must possess O'Level credit passes in five relevant subjects which must include:

- (i) English, Mathematics and Physics
- (ii) Plus any two (2) of Geography, Economics, Chemistry, Biology/Agricultural Science/Animal Husbandry, Government/Civic Education, Further Mathematics, ICT/Data Processing//Computer, Book Keeping/Accounting, Carpentry & Joinery/Woodwork/ Fine Art/Technical Drawing/Building Drawing

3.4 SCHOOL OF SCIENCE AND COMPUTER STUDIES

Applicants must possess WASC/SSCE/NECO/NABTEB/GCE O'Level with Credit passes in five (5) relevant subjects obtained at not more than two sittings.

(A) Computer Studies

Applicants must possess O'Level credit passes in five relevant subjects which must include:

- (i) English, Mathematics and Physics
- (ii) Any two (2) of Chemistry, Further Mathematics, Biology/Agricultural Science/Animal Husbandry/Food and Nutrition, Geography/Economics/Commerce, Data Processing/Computer/ICT

(B) Food Technology

Applicants must possess O'Level credit passes in five relevant subjects which must include:

- (i) English, Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry
- (ii) Plus any one (1) of Biology, Agricultural Science, Food and Nutrition, Animal Husbandry

(C) Mathematics and Statistics

Applicants must possess O'Level credit passes in five relevant subjects which must include:

- (i) English and Mathematics
- (ii) One (1) Basic Science subject from Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Agricultural Science
- (iii) Plus any two (2) of Geography, Physics, Chemistry, Biology/Agricultural Science/Animal Husbandry, Government/Civic Education, Economics/Commerce, Further Mathematics, Statistics, ICT/Data Processing/Computer

(D) Science Technology

Applicants must possess WASC/SSCE/NECO/NABTEB/GCE O'Level with Credit passes in five (5) relevant subjects which must include:

- (i) English, Mathematics, Physics and Chemistry
- (ii) plus any one (1) of Biology/Agricultural Science, Animal Husbandry

4.0 METHOD OF APPLICATION

Candidates seeking for admission into the Federal Polytechnic, Ado-Ekiti are required to complete the institution's application form available on-line at www.fedpolyado.edu.ng with effect from the day of publication spanning three (3) months.
